

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- **1.2** The following prescriptions of US SAILING will apply.
- **1.3** The *Equipment Rules of Sailing* will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **2.1** As intended, the regatta is fun in nature and yachts are expected not to participate with more crew than there are sleeping accommodations for on the vessel.
- 2.2 The regatta is open to all boats and classes. One-design classes with four or more entries will also be recognized.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to **Huguenot Yacht Club**, **Harbor Lane West**, **New Rochelle**, **NY 10805-1399** or Fax (914) 636-0146, by 3 July 2006.
- **2.4** Late entries will be accepted subject to a \$20 surcharge.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The Entry Fee will be \$50. Entry fees should be made by check payable to the Huguenot Yacht Club. Entries will not be valid until payment is received.
- **3.2** Mooring reservations at Northport Yacht Club, Regatta dinners at NYC, and Awards Barbeque at Huguenot are additional and are not included in this Entry Fee.

4 RACE FORMAT

The regatta will consist of a two races in pursuit format individually scored and not as a series.

5 SCHEDULE

- **5.1** Late Registration: Saturday and 8 July 2006 from 0800 to 1000
- 5.2 Dates of racing: 8 & 9 July 2006 all classes.
- **5.3** Number of races: All Classes one race per day
- The scheduled time of the warning signal for the Saturday's race is 1100. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the Sunday's race is 1200.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid PHRF rating certificate or rating will be randomly assigned.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 0800 on 8 July 2006 at Huguenot Yacht Club.

8 VENUE & COURSES

- 8.1 At 1100, Saturday, 8 July 2006 the rendezvous for the start will be at Green Can "1" 0.8 nm north of Execution Rocks and the Finish will be Green Gong "15" 0.9 nm north of Lloyd Point.
- 8.2 At 1200, Sunday, 9 July 2006 the rendezvous for the start will be at Green Gong "15" 0.9 nm north of Lloyd Point and the Finish will be. Green Can "1" 0.8 nm north of Execution Rocks
- **8.3** The courses to be sailed will be from the start to finish as described in above. If wind conditions are deemed to be insufficient to start, the start will be moved to a buoy closer to the finish as outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

- **9.1** Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required. This changes RRS 44.1 and 44.2
- **9.2** Appendix 'P' (Immediate penalties for breaking Rule 42) shall apply.

10 SCORING

- **10.1** The first boat to finish will be first; the second boat to finish will be second; the third boat to finish will be third and so forth.
- **10.2** Teams will be scored on the aggregate overall positions of the individual boats comprising the team.

11 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with Huguenot Yacht Club burgee and Blue Race Committee Flags.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- **12.1** A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- **12.2** Race information will be given on VHF Channel 73.

13 PRIZES

- **13.1** Daily Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place as well as many miscellaneous things that have nothing to do with racing or performance.
- **13.2** Teams of two boats, one spinnaker one non-spinnaker, can be formed for whatever reason, and will be awarded indiscriminately.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
